No experience is necessary. The workshop is about learning how to assemble hive material and at the same time providing cost effective hive kits for members of the GDBC.

The aim of the workshop will be to assemble a number of 8 frame single box hive kits that will be available for members of the GDBC to purchase for swarm catching in the coming spring.

Each kit includes: $1 \times \text{lid}$, $1 \times \text{base}$, $1 \times \text{box}$ and $8 \times \text{frames}$ with plastic foundation.

The material is being provided at the flat-pack rate of \$125 for each kit and can be picked up at the end of the workshop and taken home after it has been assembled by the workshop attendees.



RECIPE

HONEY ALMOND SLICE

(20 serves) Preheat oven 180c (160c fan forced)

SHORTBREAD BASE ³/₄ cup unsalted butter 75g caster sugar 1 ¹/₂ cups plain flour 30g corn flour

ALMOND HONEY TOPPING 3 Cups flaked almonds 75g unsalted butter ¼ cup sugar 1 1/2Tablespoons honey

Beat together butter and sugar until light and fluffy.

Sift together flours then add to the butter and sugar in three lots until fully incorporated.

Lightly pull together dough with your hands and break into chunks and scatter over your tray.

Press down on the dough until it joins together and fills in the gaps.

Bake for 20 min until it is starting to turn golden on the edges. Cool while you prepare the topping.

Place almonds in a large bowl and set aside.

Mix together the butter, sugar and honey in a saucepan over low heat until the sugar dissolves.

Pour the mixture all over the almonds and mix well.Gently spread all over the shortbread base and cook for a further 15 minutes until the top is golden.

Allow to cool before breaking into chunks.
